Horizons in Ethics & Emerging Technologies

The Scuola di Studi Superiori “Ferdinando Rossi” (SSST) of the University of Turin and the Hub for Ethics and Emerging Technologies (HEET), based at the Department of Philosophy and Educational Sciences (University of Turin), in view of the conference Horizons in Ethics & Emerging Technologies, scheduled to take place at Collegio Carlo Alberto (Turin) on 16 April 2026, **announce fifteen (15) scholarships to support the participation of master’s and/or PhD students at the conference.**

Scholarship Call

SSST and HEET announce a competition for 15 scholarships intended for master’s (or single-cycle master’s) students and doctoral researchers.

Scholarship Amount

Each scholarship consists of a **flat-rate contribution** to support participation-related expenses (e.g., travel, accommodation, and meals). The amount is:

- €350 for applicants enrolled in an institution outside the Piedmont Region and/or residing outside the Piedmont Region;
- €250 for applicants residing in the Piedmont Region or enrolled in an institution located in the Piedmont Region.

Applications will be evaluated under the same criteria regardless of the applicable tier (€350/€250).

Eligibility Requirements

- a) Applicants must be **under 35 years of age** at the deadline of this call.
- b) At the deadline of this call, candidates must fulfill one or more of the following conditions:

- currently enrolled in a master's (or single-cycle master's) degree program at an Italian or foreign university;
- currently enrolled in a doctoral program at an Italian or foreign university;
- have obtained a master's (or single-cycle master's) degree between 1 January 2022 and the call's deadline.

Application Submission and Required Documents

Applications must be submitted electronically to cristiano.cali@unito.it with the subject "Scholarship Application – Horizons Conference 2026" by the absolute deadline of [28 February 2026, 23:59 CET.

The application must include the following documents in digital format (PDF):

- copy of identity document;
- curriculum vitae et studiorum;
- proof of enrollment in a master's or doctoral program, or master's degree certificate (and transcript/marks where available);
- short motivation statement (max 500 words) explaining the applicant's interest in the conference and relevance to their study/research;
- consent to the processing of personal data (drafted on plain paper).

Scholarship Awarding

The Selection Committee, after reviewing the submitted documents, reserves the right to request an interview with candidates. The outcome of the selection, based on the irrevocable judgment of the Committee, **will be announced by 31 March 2026**.

Attendance and Payment

Scholarship recipients must attend the conference in **full**. Attendance will be verified by the Organizing Committee through sign-in procedures during the event. **The scholarship will be paid in a single lump-sum installment following verified attendance.** The Organizing Committee reserves the right to suspend scholarship payment and withhold the issuance of the relevant certification in case of serious non-compliance.






